


ANCHOR IRONS

New symbols are added

An anchor iron is a device in a building that holds different parts together with an inserted iron piece. This way, wooden and iron beams are anchored into an adjacent masonry by attaching anchor irons to the beams. The anchor iron typically ends with a forged loop known as an anchor end.

These irons and their design are a new addition to the Vasuma design palette. You will be seeing them in the future on both frames and other material.

TITANIUM & SWEDISH STEEL Vasuma metal frames are known for their resistance, hardness, and elasticity. We use the highest quality raw materials from Swedish Sandvik. Our Japanese partner utilizes titanium to create lightweight, durable frames that exude sophistication and style.

hen Jan and Lars grew up in the 70s and 80s, wearing glasses made them frequent targets of teasing at school. They often heard "Four Eyes" shouted at them in the school corridors, a term equivalent to the Swedish "Glasögonorm," meaning "Eyewear Snake."

When Vasuma was created, its mission was to empower all "Glasögonormar" by making eyewear cool, putting an end to teasing. The snake theme is prevalent in the naming of all frames, each named after a different snake. "Glasögonorm" is also the Swedish term for the Cobra snake, whose shield inspired the Vasuma Cobra symbol—a letter "V" with glasses.




THREE FRIENDS START VASUMA

he Vasuma headquarters in I Old Town, hosts the design, marketing, administration and management division, as well as the archive of prototypes and handmade eyewear. Our block, called "Pygmalion," is one of the most unique buildings in Old

Town. Spanning four floors, it was once a hostel and washing facility with a medieval well that has an eerie resemblance to the one in "The Silence of the Lambs." In 1438, when skipper Claus Tykeson acquired the house, he prohibited the use of the well, leading to numerous disputes and court cases, which ultimately favored the public and neighbors.
